RULES for 2010 COMPETITION

Theme: 'Harmony - we can make it happen'

DESIGN BRIEF

CONTENT: All entries must illustrate the theme 'Harmony - we can make it happen'

SIZE: All entries must be A3 poster size (297mm x 420mm) either portrait or landscape. Posters smaller or larger than this size will be excluded from judging.

MEDIUM: Posters may be watercolour, acrylic, oil, pastels, crayon, colour pencil, gouache, photographs, computer graphics, collage or assemblage.

ORIGINALITY: All art work submitted must be the original work of the student/s whose name/s appear on the entry form.

ENTERING THE COMPETITION

Posters may be submitted by individual students or by groups of students. Posters submitted by groups of students will require an entry form for each participating student. Entry Forms can be submitted either on-line or in writing.
